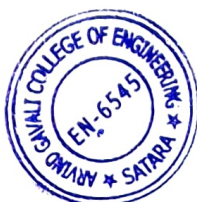

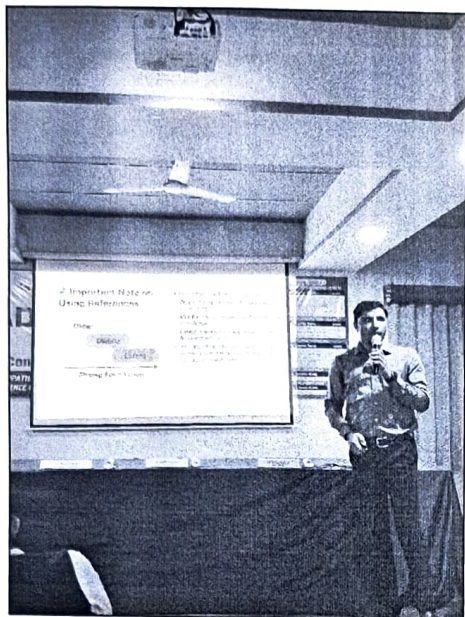

About the Program/Activity:
